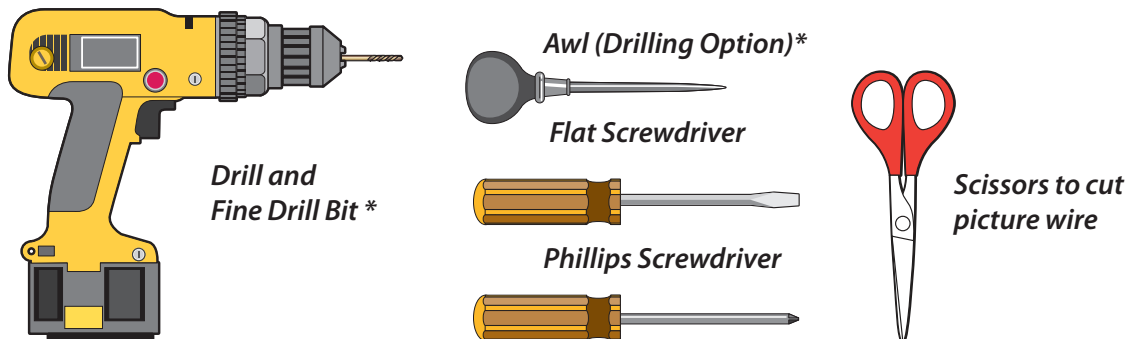


Preparing Your Artwork for Display

Installing picture hanging hardware

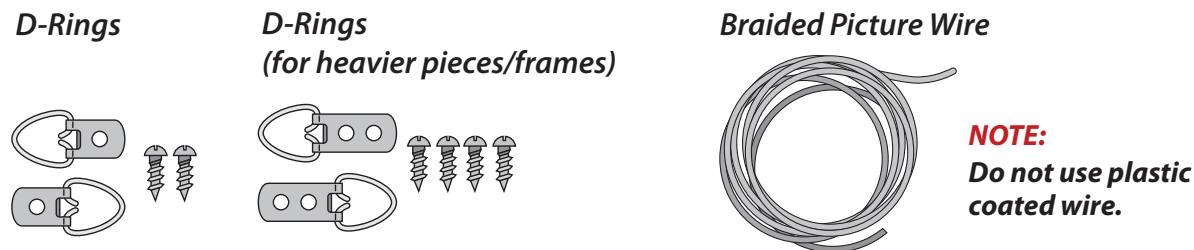
Guide is designed to help you prepare your art for display in McGuffey Art Center galleries.

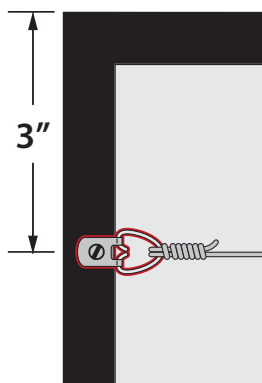

Required hanging hardware for use our gallery hanging system

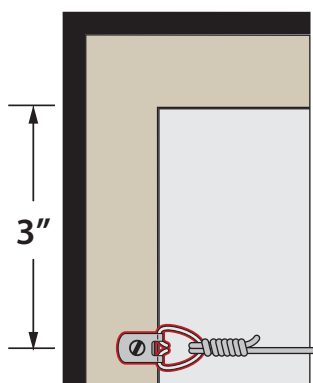


Hardware: Installation and Placement of Hanging Hardware

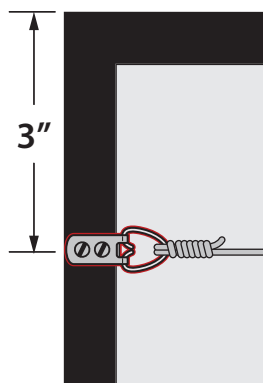
Standard
Use 1-screw hardware & make sure ring is inside stretcher (as shown)



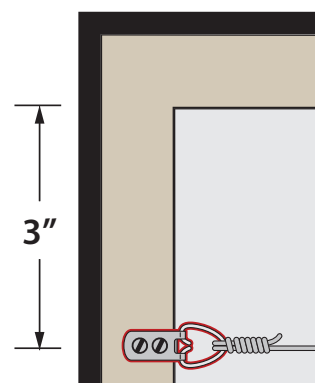
Work on Canvas
Use 1-screw hardware & make sure ring is inside stretcher (as shown)



Large Heavy Piece (framed)
& make sure ring is inside stretcher (as shown)

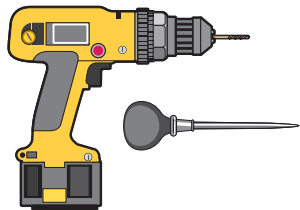


Large Work on Canvas
Use 2-screw hardware & make sure ring is inside stretcher (as shown)



NOTE: Picture wire should be taught so that gallery clips are not visible above the top edge of the frame.

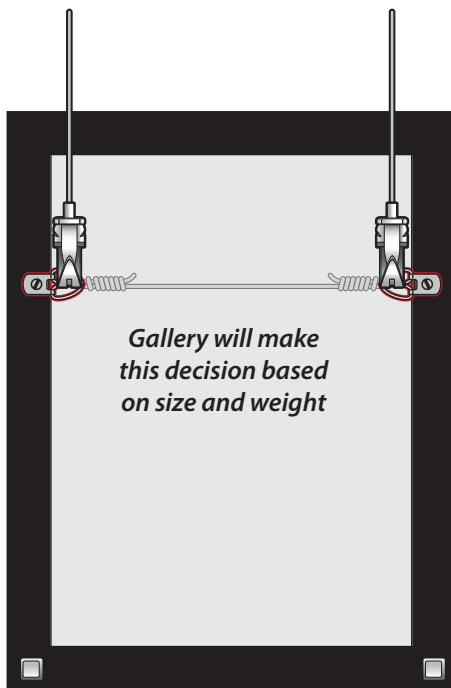
Hardware: Installation and Placement (continued)



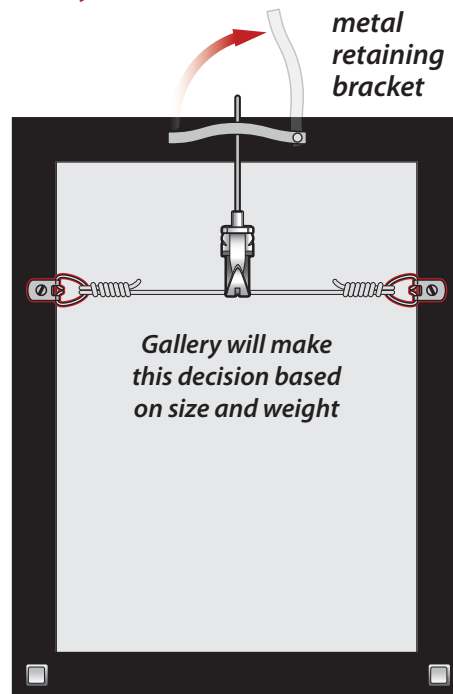
NOTE: Predrill the screw holes to make installing screws easier, and to keep from splitting your frame, stretcher, or art substrate. Pull the wire taught.

Add pads or bumpers to the corners of your work

Gallery decision



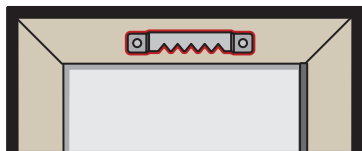
Gallery clips attached to wire

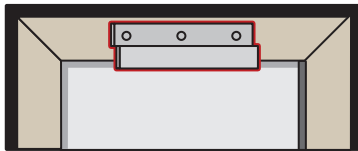
We may add a metal retaining bracket as indicated at top of frame. If your work has this bracket, please ask a gallery assistant to take the work off the wall.
Do not cut the Gallery Clip wire!

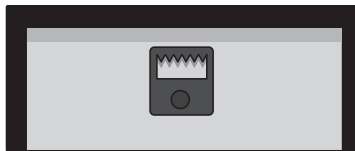
Sawtooth Hangers
